Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 916 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 3rd – Tuesday, 15th December, 2020.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.




Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.





(Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)




Q.8 And to which one of these groupings or types of Independents would you give your first preference vote?

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted between Thursday 3rd and Tuesday, 15th December, 2020. Due to Level 5 nationwide lockdown, there was no poll conducted in November, with the last comparable survey published in October.

Interviewing for this month's poll was carried out after all shops, hairdressers and gyms had been allowed to reopen, but before the full easing of restrictions on nationwide travel for the Christmas period. Indeed, as we approach the festive season, the freedom of travel that the easing of restrictions will bring is tempered by concerns around a third potential lockdown in the New Year, and this uncertainty will undoubtedly have had an effect on consumer sentiment as expressed in the survey.

The public will, however have taken considerable comfort from the recent announcements around effective vaccines and the likely rollout of global vaccination programmes during the first part of 2021.

At the same time, Brexit negotiations reached a critical juncture as survey work progressed, with most of the interviews completed before signs of optimism emerged around a potential trade deal.

All in all therefore, the Irish electorate has experienced a rollercoaster of emotions over the last month or so, with the effects of this dynamic measured in today's report.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

The headline story from today's poll is a rise in satisfaction with both the Government and Micheál Martin as Taoiseach, and a counter-balancing drop in satisfaction with Leo Varadkar as Tánaiste .

Correspondingly, support for Fianna Fáil has increased three points since October, with Fine Gael support dropping four points over the same period. Sinn Féin is again the most popular party in the country, and has opened a 5 percentage point gap over its nearest rival, Fine Gael.

It is perhaps no surprise that Micheál Martin and Fianna Fáil's standing has improved amongst the electorate given the ongoing easing of restrictions and related good news emanating from the Taoiseach's office around an imminent vaccination programme. Having said that, while the Taoiseach's personal rating has increased by 7 points since October, he still lags behind both Leo Varadkar and Mary Lou McDonald who both attract a 50% favourability rating, and is just on a par with Alan Kelly as leader of the Labour Party in the popularity stakes.

At a macro level, as we approach the end of 2020 the country is divided on its view of the manner in which the Government is running the country, with 44% satisfied and 46% dissatisfied. Positivity towards the Government's performance is highest amongst those aged 55 years+ (at 51% satisfaction), and in the Dublin area where 51% are happy with the Government and 41% are not. Indeed, these are the very same sections of the population that register highest levels of satisfaction with the way Micheál Martin is doing his job as Taoiseach, suggesting perhaps that people are beginning to see Martin settling a little more comfortably into the role of leader of the nation.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

The fact that Varadkar and McDonald share pole position as most popular party leaders in the country confirms the ongoing trend towards the electorate possibly facing a stark choice at the next general election, between a left-leaning administration led by Mary Lou McDonald as Taoiseach or a right of centre coalition, headed by Leo Varadkar. Meanwhile, Eamon Ryan's personal rating of 36% matches his average satisfaction score since the general election, with Alan Kelly's rating settling in around the early to mid 40's following his initial debut in the charts at 49% last July.

None of this is to ignore the fact that support for Fianna Fáil has increased by three percentage points compared to two month ago, and at 22% support the party has regained the support it seems to have lost since its 22% showing in February's General Election. While not quite yet breathing down Fine Gael's neck, there is now just a five point gap between the two coalition partners, and this will provide the soldiers of destiny with significant comfort for the year ahead.

For its part, Fine Gael's national 27% support level over-indexes amongst female voters (30%), the over-55's (32%), the farming community (48%) and in the Dublin area (32%). In fact, Fine Gael leads Sinn Féin in the capital by two percentage points, although it trails both Sinn Féin and Fianna Fáil across all rural areas.

At 32% support overall, Sinn Féin is currently the most popular party in the country, and is especially so within the broad 18-54 years age group (at 39% support) amongst the C2DE blue collar working category (40%), and also across all urban areas (33%). As for potential Sinn Féin coalition partners, the Labour Party under the leadership of Alan Kelly will be pleased to note the party's steady, albeit incremental growth from 3% support at the beginning and middle of 2020, to 4% in October, and 5% support this month.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

The Green Party will be considering means by which they can improve their standing amongst the electorate next year as its support registers at just 3% as we finish out 2020.

Finally, it is clear that the continuing popularity of Sinn Féin and, to a lesser degree, the Labour Party, has eaten into smaller parties of the left, with for example support for the Social Democrats currently at 1%, Aontu just under 1%, and Solidarity/People Before Profit at 2% nationwide.

Covid Vaccine Requirements

In October's poll we established that opinion was relatively evenly split between those who would report a bar or restaurant for failing to enforce Covid regulations and those who would not. On the other extreme, a strong majority believed that the army should not be called out to break up house parties.

This month, our attention switched to the question as to whether people feel individuals should be required to take an EU approved vaccine under a number of different scenarios.

Remarkably, a majority of all respondents were of the view that people should be required to take such a vaccine under all circumstances suggested.

Specifically, three-quarters feel that people should be required to take the vaccine before they enter high risk settings such as hospitals and nursing homes, two-thirds believe a vaccine should be mandatory before people take a flight and six in ten feel that students should have to receive the vaccine before they attend school or college in person.

In general, resistance to the mandatory taking of vaccines is highest amongst people aged under 35 years, as well as amongst supporters of Sinn Féin.
