# Technical Appendix

## Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 931 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



## Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> – Tuesday, 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.



## Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.




## Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



## Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



## Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



# Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown



# Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend





# Commentary

## Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted between Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> and Tuesday, 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2020. As such, the country was under level 3 restrictions, with a general expectation that this would be upgraded to level 4 for some or all counties imminently.

It is safe to say therefore that the Government's management of the Covid-19 crisis was the primary concern of most people during the survey's fieldwork period, with a continued absence of a vaccine and the looming Christmas period feeding into a general sense of gloom.

At the same time, Brexit negotiations were reaching the final stage, with growing business and consumer concern as to the likely impact of a no deal on their fortunes.

All in all, therefore, voters' nerves were collectively frayed in the lead up to today's poll, with interviewing all but complete by the time the budget was announced on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>.

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Despite the debacle of the Leaving Certificate grades errors and the traumatic effect it had on vast swathes of the population, satisfaction with the performance of the Government has stabilised month-on-month to a point where four in ten are currently happy with the administration. This represents a statistically insignificant increase of two percentage points since September and is significantly higher than the 30% satisfaction rating the out-going Government received a month before the last election.

It is still however the case that a small majority (52%) of the populace is unhappy with the Government, and this is particularly so amongst males, the broad family stage 35 to 54 year old cohort, rural dwellers, and C2DE blue collar workers.

Undoubtedly the Government's handling of the pandemic between now and Christmas will dictate whether it can reach the 51% satisfaction level it achieved in July of this year when the first wave of the virus had been brought under control.

Meanwhile, Leo Varadkar as Tánaiste remains by far the most popular party leader in the country, with six in ten voters indicating they are satisfied with the job he is doing, and less than a third dissatisfied. Varadkar has of course maintained as high a public profile as Tánaiste as when he was Taoiseach, and has made a habit of publicly announcing key Government decisions before the Taoiseach or other colleagues have had a chance to do so.

Whatever about the politics of his strategy, it is clear that Varadkar is viewed by many not so much as Tánaiste, but as Taoiseach-in-waiting. His popularity is especially high amongst females (63%), those aged over 55 years (70%), and ABC1 white collar and professional workers (65%).

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Just eight months ago Sinn Féin pushed Fianna Fáil into second place and Fine Gael into third in the General Election, and in one fell swoop ended our one hundred year two-party system. Idle commentary when Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael subsequently formed a coalition predicted that the two entities would ultimately be subsumed into each other and, more recently, that Fianna Fáil could disappear altogether to give way to a new Fine Gael-Sinn Féin axis.

Thus far, these predictions are proving only partly true, insofar as Sinn Féin and Fine Gael have been neck and neck with each other in the polls, with both parties having increased their share of the vote significantly since the election.

For example, Fine Gael support is now significantly higher than its share of the vote in February across all demographic groupings and regional areas. Sinn Féin achieved just over 24% of the vote in the last election, and its support does not drop below this level in any demographic grouping, although it does come close amongst the over 55's and the ABC1 socio-economic category.

Fianna Fáil, while currently trailing in the polls by three percentage points compared to its general election performance, is far from facing extinction, and it is the second most popular party for people aged 55 years and older, and those living in the Munster region.

If Fianna Fáil can begin to recover from its disastrous first few months in office and lead the country into a post-Covid recovery, there is every chance that come the 2024/2025 election we will again be in the throes of a three horse race.

## Covid Restriction Breaches

With ultimate responsibility for abiding by Covid-related restrictions resting with citizens themselves, we decided to test in today's poll, how far people would be willing to go in reporting those not abiding by the rules.

At a basic human level, there is something of a difference in people's propensity to report a stranger not wearing a mask or a business not enforcing social distancing guidelines on the one hand, and reporting a neighbour for breaking the rules, on the other.

Thus, 44% of us would report a bar or restaurant for failing to enforce regulations on social distancing, number of people in a party or closing times, while 46% would not do so. This willingness to take action against errant bars or restaurants is highest in urban areas and cities, where population densities are highest, and the risk of Covid infection therefore greatest.

Conversely just over a third (37%) of Irish voters would report a neighbour for having a house party, while 51% would not. A further 13% don't know how they would respond in such circumstances – presumably it would depend on how well they know the neighbour, and how raucous the party was!

Survey respondents were also asked whether they believed that the army should be called out to police street and home parties. Here, the response is more clear-cut, with just a third believing the army should be called in to break up such parties, and 60% of the view that they should not be. There is just one exception to this finding – with 46% of those supporting the soldiers of destiny indicating they would call for back-up, and just 44% of them ruling it out.
