Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 914 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Tuesday 4th – Tuesday 18th May, 2021.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.




Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individual's stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.





Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend








Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes poll was conducted over the period Tuesday 4th to Tuesday, 18th May, 2021.

Remarkably, this is the first B&A opinion poll of 2021. The last comparable survey was carried out last December in the days leading up to the Christmas period and ultimately, near-complete National lockdown.

With the recent easing of restrictions, and the capacity for survey interviewers to travel between counties around the country, only now has it been possible to return to B&A's Gold standard face-to-face opinion polling methodology.

All survey work conducted for today's poll was executed in strict adherence to public health and Government guidelines, with interviewing conducted on respondents' doorsteps at the required distance, and our interviewers equipped with the required PPE kit.

In many respects, there has been just one political story over the last five months – the on-going battle against Covid-19, and the collective effort to defeat the virus and reclaim some sense of normality.

Compared to the national sense of despondency and frustration evident in the early months of 2021, there is no doubt that the national spirit has been lifted over the last month in particular as the vaccination programme has gained significant traction.

Background

At the time of writing, 40% of all adults have received their first vaccination, and we are well on course to have a majority of the population at least partially vaccinated by the middle of next month. Despite the heartbreak of the last 12 to 14 months, this can only be described as a good news story, and the Government deserves its share of credit for these achievements.

Against this relatively positive backdrop, Government parties have begun to take the initiative on the non-Covid issues that are likely to affect the result of the next General Election. Specifically, Micheál Martin has declared Housing as the country's top priority after Covid, a sure sign that when the Dáil reconvenes in September after the summer recess, we will witness a resumption of intense hostilities between Government and Opposition Parties on a range of domestic issues.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

It is interesting to note that the highest level of satisfaction achieved by the current Government was registered at 51% in July of last year, at a time when significant Government restrictions had been lifted and we were being encouraged to relax and holiday in our favourite spots around the country.

By the middle of September, Government satisfaction had dropped precipitously to 38%, as the Covid situation was again deteriorating. Since then, the Government's rating has improved steadily, to a point this month whereby 47% are satisfied with the manner in which the Government is running the country, and 45% are dissatisfied.

I would read this almost equal split in public sentiment as reflective of the broader Irish political landscape, where approximately half of the electorate is in the Fianna Fail/Fine Gael camp, and half is already looking towards the opposition for solutions to the challenges facing a post pandemic Ireland.

Similarly, our poll indicates that roughly half of all voters are satisfied with Micheál Martin as Taoiseach, Leo Varadkar as Tánaiste, Mary Lou McDonald as leader of Sinn Féin and Alan Kelly as leader of the Labour Party.

There is one critical insight hidden within these overall satisfaction ratings however. It might reasonably be expected that the great majority of those satisfied with the main opposition leader, Mary Lou McDonald would be highly unlikely to vote for either Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael and that those likely to vote for the two Government parties would be overwhelmingly dissatisfied with McDonald.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

In reality, only part of this hypothesis holds true. Thus, around seven in ten Sinn Féin voters indicate that they are unhappy with the performance of Micheál Martin and Leo Varadkar, with just a quarter of them rating their performance positively.

Conversely however, marginally more Fianna Fáil voters (47%) are satisfied with Mary Lou McDonald than are dissatisfied (45%). A sizeable 40% of Fine Gael supporters also express satisfaction with McDonald's performance as leader of her party, compared to 48% who are dissatisfied.

The implication here is an important one – very significant proportions of those who are firmly in the Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael camp still view the leader of Sinn Féin in a positive light.

As a potential future Taoiseach, McDonald clearly does not carry any of the baggage of her predecessor Gerry Adams – confirmation that Sinn Féin has successfully transitioned in the mind of the electorate to the status of mainstream political party.

Party support levels are actually very similar in today's poll compared to last December's. As such, Sinn Féin remains the most popular party in the country at 30% support, followed closely by Fine Gael on 28%. There is no doubt from the figures that the key battle for the hearts and minds of the Irish public is between a centre-right proposition led by Fine Gael, and a left of centre alternative led by Sinn Féin. The question then becomes which of the remaining parties will assume the role of kingmaker or kingmakers after the next election.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Fianna Fáil support has been reasonably consistent over the last 18 months or so, and currently stands at 22%. If today's poll results were replicated in the next election, Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil would have a combined share of 50% of the vote, which would be more than enough to return them to Government for a second term. It is, to put it mildly, debatable whether either of these two parties would be willing to enter into such an arrangement yet again, and a simple two party coalition between Sinn Féin and Fianna Fáil certainly cannot be ruled out, assuming Micheál Martin is replaced as leader of his party in the meantime.

The other potential coalition is a Green and Red tinged partnership including Sinn Féin, The Green Party, The Labour Party, Social Democrats and People Before Profit.

While such a Government could be relatively short-lived due to the inherent instability in balancing the needs of such a wide array of political parties, it may well represent to a majority of the electorate the type of change they desire.

Attitudes Towards All Ireland Vote

Given the implementation of Brexit with an effective border down the Irish Sea, the growing momentum for a second independence vote in Scotland, and indeed the increasing clamour for a vote on a United Ireland by Sinn Féin, today's poll looked at attitudes towards an All Ireland vote on a United Ireland being held within the next five years, and how people might vote in such a referendum.

As things stand today, two-thirds of all Irish voters are in favour of an All Ireland vote on a United Ireland being held within the next five years. One in five are opposed to the holding of such a vote, with the remainder undecided.

In the event of such a vote being held in the near future, two-thirds of all Irish voters indicate they would vote for a United Ireland, 17% would vote against it, with 18% undecided.

Support for an all Ireland vote on the issue is highest amongst males, those aged 18 to 34 years, residents of Leinster and Munster, and supporters of Fianna Fáil and Sinn Féin.

Voters in Dublin are most likely of all to be opposed to holding a vote on a United Ireland (30%), and also most likely to vote against a United Ireland if such a vote was held (25%).
