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#### **Technical Appendix**



#### **Sample Size**

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 909 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



#### **Fieldwork**

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an inhome, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May
– Tuesday, 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.



#### Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.





#### Technical Appendix



#### Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



#### **Party Support**

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



#### **Guidelines**

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



(excluding undecided/adjusted)





# Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend









#### **Background**

Fieldwork for today's Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes poll was conducted over the period Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May to Tuesday, 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

This is just the second B&A Opinion Poll of 2021, with fieldwork for our May survey ending just nine days before commencement of interviewing for today's poll. As has been the case with all face-to-face survey work conducted by B&A throughout the Pandemic, interviewing was executed in strict adherence to public health and Government guidelines, with all required social distancing and PPE kit protocols followed.

Since last month's survey, the proportion of adults that have received their first vaccination has increased from circa 40% to over 55%, while more than a quarter of the adult population is by now fully vaccinated.

Apart from the pandemic, the political landscape has been reasonably quiet in the weeks leading up to today's survey, a calm which is likely to be disrupted over the coming weeks in Dublin at least, as campaigning for the Dublin Bay South By-Election begins.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Since our last poll, there has been no change in the Government's satisfaction rating of 47% nationwide. Those aged 55 years+, and individuals from a farming background are most satisfied of all with the manner in which the Government is running the country, with eight in ten Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael supporters happy with the job their parties have been doing over recent weeks.

As was the case in May, Micheál Martin, Leo Varadkar and Mary Lou McDonald are neck in neck with each other in the party leader popularity stakes, with McDonald's rating having increased three percentage points to 52% since last month. This increase in support for the Sinn Féin leader is most pronounced amongst female voters (up 6 percentage points), 18 to 34 year olds (up 8 points) and in Dublin (up 6 points).

With regard to party support, it is worth noting that more than one in five of the electorate remains undecided as to who they might vote for in the event of a General Election – the equivalent of circa 750,000 floating voters, the views of whom will be critical in decided the composition of the next Government.

Since July of last year, support levels for the various parties have been remarkably consistent in the B&A Poll series. Thus, in the five surveys conducted up until May, the average level of support for Fianna Fáil has been 20%, for Fine Gael it has averaged out at 29%, for the Labour Party it has been just under 4% and for Sinn Féin, the average support level has been 31%. The Green Party has attracted 4% or 5% support over the same period.

Compared to these averages, today's poll registers no change in the average level of support for Fianna Fáil at 20%, a significant drop of 5 percentage points on Fine Gael's average five month rating to 24% today, no significant change for Labour or the Green Party, and a marginally significant increase of three percentage points in support for Sinn Féin.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Increase in support for all other smaller parties plus Independents has also increased 3 percentage points over the period from 16% to 19%.

Today's is of course a movement in support levels to watch over the next few B&A polls – i.e. to track whether the drop in combined support for Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil from 50% in May to 44% this June is the beginning of a trend, or merely a function of Covid fatigue.

In attempting to interpret this month's drop in Fine Gael support, it is useful to note that the most significant declines for the party have been amongst males (a drop of 5 percentage points since last month), 18 to 34 years (a drop of 7 points), 35 to 54 year olds (down 6 points), ABC1 white collar and professional working individuals (down 7 points), and in the Leinster region (down 10 points).

Conversely, the increase in Sinn Féin support is most notable with female voters (up 7 percentage points), 18 to 34 year olds (up 5 points), C2DE working individuals (up 8 points) and in the Leinster (up 7 points) and Munster (up 8 points) regions.

Also of note is the uplift in support from 2% in May to 4% this month in support for the Social Democrats – a party which commands 6% of 35 to 54 year old's support, 6% within the ABC1 socio-economic group, and 5% in the broad Dublin and Leinster regions.

Also, today's is the third poll in the B&A series where Aontu has broken through to register 1% support nationwide, with evidence that its popularity is highest with older voters, and in the Munster area.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

This is of course just one poll in a series – the proverbial 'snapshot in time'. It will be many months if not years before the polls can give us accurate forecasts of the likely outcome of the next election. In the meantime, the results of next month's Dublin Bay South by election will have to do as a meaningful gauge of how the parties are doing.



#### **Irish Charity Contribution & Regulation**

An estimated two million Irish adults aged 18 or more claim that they contribute to an Irish charity once a year or more often. This behaviour is significantly higher amongst females, the over 55 year olds, residents of Dublin, and the more financially comfortable ABC1 socio-economic category.

Interestingly, highest levels of contributing to Irish charities are registered amongst core Fine Gael voters, with lowest levels by Sinn Féin supporters.

Two-thirds of the public are concerned that there is currently not enough regulation and oversight of Irish charities, with a further 15% uncertain in this regard.

Despite these concerns, seven in ten of all Irish adults report giving either the same amount or more to Irish charities nowadays compared to a year or two ago, although 22% are now giving less.
