Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 928 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 27th January to 8th February, 2022.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.




Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



(excluding undecided/adjusted)







Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend






Intentions to holiday in 2022

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 27th January to Tuesday 8th February, 2022.

As of 6am on Saturday 22 January, many restrictions were lifted effectively resulting in a reopening of Ireland. The scale and immediacy of the 'opening' came as a shock to many, albeit welcomed for the most part. This is the background to this poll. In fact over the polling period case numbers started to take a back seat in the media, with a return to more 'normal' news reports, this was despite Covid numbers remaining quite high.

New topics of interest were both Irish and international, which also reflected a shift in emphasis. At home, the disturbing subject of aggression and violence towards women was covered extensively in the media. The Women of Honour also met the Taoiseach. The HSE apologised regarding care deficiencies in South Kerry Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS). Also post Covid politics appeared to be returning at full throttle, with sparring on more traditional issues such as housing and the cost of living in full swing. Inflation and the cost of living are likely to remain dominate topics for the foreseeable future and will shape the political landscape for large cohorts of the electorate.

Elsewhere, Partygate was in full swing in Downing street (and to a lesser extent here), and the drums of war were beating about the Ukranian situation. As we now look to a life with Covid, and rebuilding Ireland, it was fantastic to see CNN reporting on 'How a group of Irish fishermen forced the Russian Navy into a U-turn'. Given our need to attract tourists and workers, this was welcome publicity for Ireland Inc. More of the same positive news about Ireland is required.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Government satisfaction is up two percentage points (not significant) from January and stands at 46%. Note this is a six percentage point increase on satisfaction levels for the Government since December 2021. These scores match the Government's highest recorded level in 2021. Just under half (46%) remain dissatisfied with the current Government. Satisfaction levels with the Government are higher amongst older and more middle class voters with blue collar cohorts remaining significantly less satisfied.

In line with the increase in Government satisfaction, both Micheál Martin and Leo Varadkar see their satisfaction ratings improve in February. Both Micheál Martin and Leo Varadkar's ratings have increased by 3 percentage points, with Martin's increasing to 51% while Varadkar's increased to 44%. Micheál Martin now vies with Mary Lou McDonald for the most popular leader title (both on 51% satisfaction). Mary Lou McDonald has been the most consistent performer over the last number of polls.

Eamon Ryan's satisfaction stands at 33%, similar to the January poll. Alan Kelly's satisfaction moves up one percentage point to 43% of the electorate satisfied with his performance.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Sinn Féin support continues to remain very steady, with 34% of the electorate indicating they would vote for the party in the event of a General Election and they remain by far the most popular party.

Fianna Fáil support remains ahead of Fine Gael with 25% of the electorate likely to vote for this party in the event of a General Election (up one percentage point). Fine Gael stand at 20% (down two percentage points). Labour remain on 4%. The Green Party has recovered their two percentage point loss in the last poll to stand at 5% support.

As mentioned in our January poll, as the country emerges from the Pandemic, the lens will be focused on issues which closely impact people's lives (housing, cost of living, inflation, etc), with COVID taking a backseat. In addition, the economic and socio-cultural landscape that emerges from the Pandemic will take shape over the next 12-18 months.

Note we are only 3-4 weeks into 'normality', thus it will take us time to adjust to the light. Hence 2022 will be an interesting year.

Holidaying and Intentions to Travel Abroad

About one-quarter (24%) of the population have left Ireland to go abroad during the Pandemic years of 2020-2022 (so far). A further quarter (24%) have not been abroad since 2019 and 44% report they have not been abroad since before 2019. About 1 in 20 (8%) have never left Ireland at any stage.

Those in Dublin and more middle class cohorts are more likely to have travelled over the Pandemic years of 2020-2022; 36% ABC1 versus 16% C2DE; 42% Dublin versus outside Dublin (18%). Interestingly, those supporting Fine Gael are more likely to have travelled over the course of 2020-2022 (35%) compared to all voters (24%).

In terms of intention to holiday anywhere in 2022, two-thirds of people (65%) plan to or have already had a holiday in Ireland or abroad in 2022. Significantly higher intentions to holiday anywhere in 2022 emerge amongst those under 35's (76%), middle classes (77%) and Dubliners (76%).

- 40% of people have already/plan to holiday abroad, - higher amongst under 35's (55%) and Dubliners (55%).
- 42% of people have already/plan to holiday in Ireland – higher for Dubliners (51% vs 38% outside Dublin) – this bodes well for Irish tourism.
- One-third of the population (35%) do not intend to holiday at all this year - more likely to be those aged 55 years+ (44%) and blue collar cohorts (44%).
