# Technical Appendix

## Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 917 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



## Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> October to Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> November.



## Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.




## Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



## Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



## Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.




# Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown








# Expected Socialising Over Christmas x Party Support




# Expect to Spend on Christmas vs Last Year x Demographics

# Commentary

## Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> October to Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2021. It was conducted against the backdrop of the Sinn Féin Ard Fheis, the Climate Action Plan launch, COP 26 and the rising tide of Covid 19 cases and hospital admissions.

The mood of the nation while more positive than earlier in the Pandemic, was also cautious. The rhetoric from the Chief Medical Officer and the Government changed to a more serious tone, voicing concern over the rising case numbers and hospitalisations. Also the 'B' word (Brexit) was firmly in play.

Thus, a mixed mood was evident in the lead up to today's poll.

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Satisfaction with the Government remains at similar levels to last month's poll (and indeed this time last year), with four in ten (38%) currently happy with its performance. However, this has been slipping since June when it stood at 47% satisfaction levels.

Higher levels of satisfaction with the Government exist amongst more middle class cohorts (44%) and Dubliners (45%). As in our last October poll, a small majority (53%) remain dissatisfied with the current Government.

In terms of party leaders, Mary Lou McDonald remains the most popular leader with 50% of the electorate satisfied with her performance, which is consistent with levels recorded throughout 2021. Her popularity is strong across all ages, with even higher ratings emanating from under 35 year old voters. Her satisfaction is weaker amongst the rural voter, compared to urban. Also while Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael supporters are more likely to be dissatisfied than satisfied with Mary Lou McDonald, Fianna Fáil supporters indicated greater satisfaction levels (44%) with her performance compared to Fine Gael supporters (27%). Therein lies the challenge for Fianna Fáil.

Micheál Martin is on a 41% satisfaction rating (albeit down from his annual high of 50% in June) by the electorate, an insignificant slippage of one percentage point on October but he remains in second place. Leo Varadkar has still not recovered from the drop in his ratings in September and stands at 39% satisfaction level with his performance for the third wave. Eamon Ryan stands on a satisfaction rating of 32%, similar to last month. Alan Kelly drops three points to 38%.

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Against the background of their Ard Fheis and positioning as a party for Government, Sinn Féin support has surged with 37% of the electorate indicating it would vote for the party in the event of a General Election. This represents a statistically significant increase of six percentage points on our October poll. It is the party's strongest poll showing since the B&A Sunday Times February 2020 poll post the last General Election. They remain the most popular party. The party is strong amongst all demographics, but particularly amongst those aged 18-34 years and more blue collar socio-economic cohorts of the population.

However, Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael are again neck and neck at 20% and 21% respectively. Note while the movements for the latter parties are not statistically significant, this represents a drop of 3% for Fianna Fáil, with Fine Gael stable on 20%. Labour has dropped two percentage points down to 3%. The Green's remain on 5% (no Climate Action Plan/COP 26 bounce!).

To what extent this Sinn Féin gap can be maintained is the question. It is likely they will settle back on our next poll. They have undoubtedly benefited from their high profile over the last few weeks, coupled with some Government indecision over the relaxing of restrictions. With an election 2-3 years away a lot could change, however they now appear to be 'talking' like a government party (moving from that challenger brand status) and they are the largest party.

Thoughts will now perhaps switch to 'how to form a potential Government'. Given they are the most popular party with the most popular leader, it does appear that fewer and fewer think of their paramilitary linkages, when they think of Sinn Féin. Interesting times indeed.

## Attitudes to Socialising & Spend Over Christmas

Almost 3 in 5 (57%) expect to socialise with friends and family over the Christmas break as they normally would have pre Covid. This is likely to give pause for concern, given the increased transmission of the virus recently. Not surprisingly those aged 18-34 and Dubliners are most primed to socialise, with those aged 55+ most hesitant in the social stakes.

Overall the population feels it will spend about the same amount as last Christmas. However propensity to spend is not evenly distributed, with younger people (18-34) and Dubliners expecting to spend more, while those aged 55+ and outside Dublin being somewhat more cautious.
