# Technical Appendix

## Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 923 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



## Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 24<sup>th</sup> November – 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.



## Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



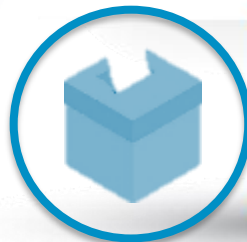
## Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



## Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



## Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

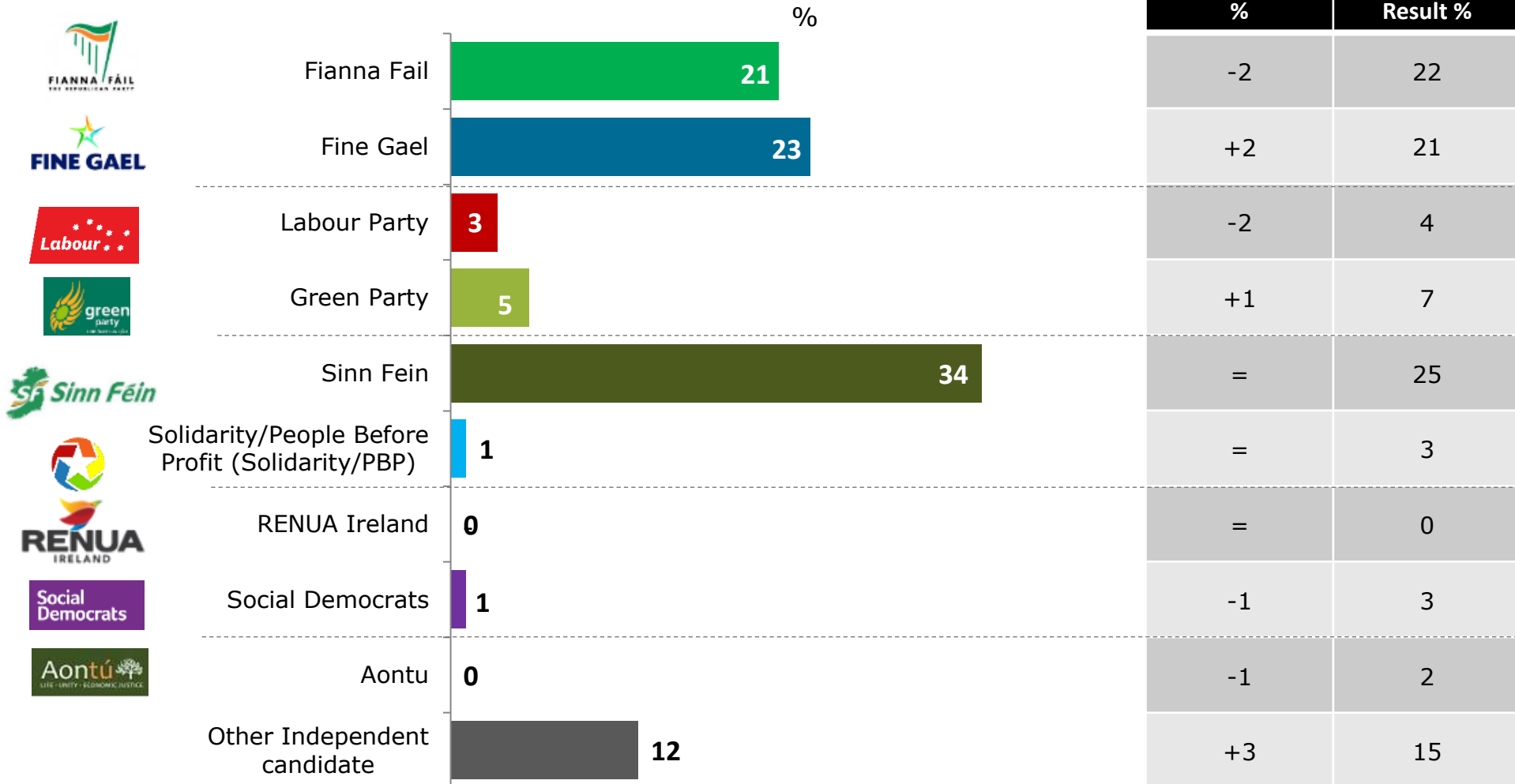

(excluding undecided/adjusted)

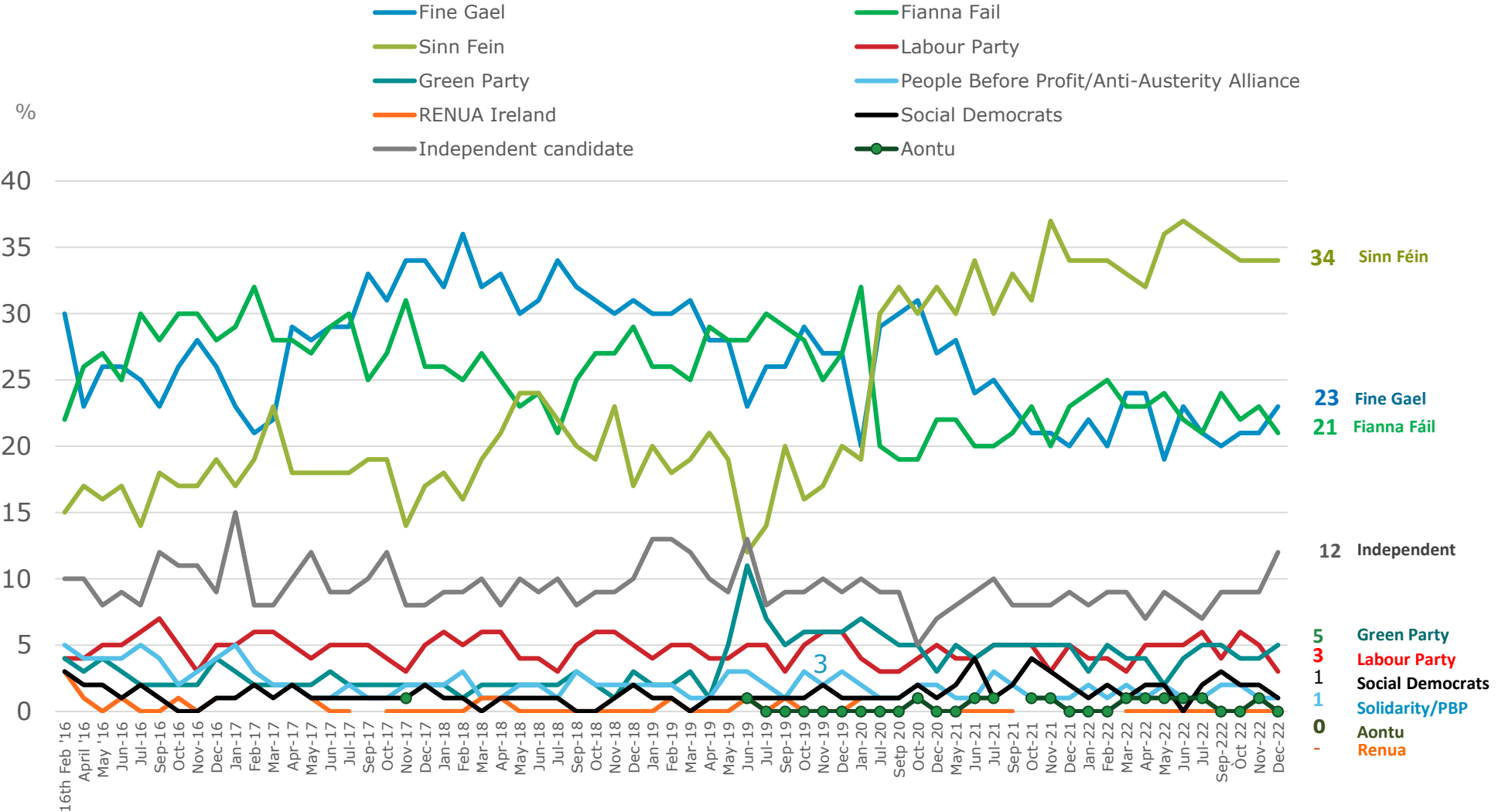

**Commentary**

## Background

- The fieldwork for this latest Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Poll was conducted between 24<sup>th</sup> November – 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.
- During this poll inflationary headlines continued, with energy and food costs being primary concerns for many households. The winter weather was starting to bite, with bills rising.
- Protests against the opening of an accommodation centre for asylum seekers in East Wall in Dublin led to some ugly scenes, with claims of protests being "hijacked" by far-right groups.
- The Taoiseach was under pressure on the housing crisis and cabinet looked to approve the return of banker bonuses.
- However, it was not all doom and gloom with the announcement of 1.3 million people receiving their Christmas Bonus over the coming weeks, at a cost of more than €300 million to the State.
- Also, it was reported that Ireland took in more corporation tax in November than it used to collect in an entire year a decade ago. Unemployment remained low, despite the high profile cutting of jobs in the Tech sector.
- Unusually for this time of year, Travel agents were experiencing a high demand for longer stay holidays in warmer countries, such as the Canary Islands and Morocco, most likely to escape the weather and inflationary prices.
- Despite the inflationary spiral, it seems that Irish people are determined to have a good Christmas and worry about the finances in the New Year. January and February will undoubtedly be quiet with many financial hangovers.



## Government and Leader Satisfaction Levels

- As the Government rotation looms, with Leo Varadkar moving upstairs to the Office of An Taoiseach, the current Government satisfaction stands at 41% (a decrease of two percentage points on November, but still five percentage points up on September).
- Half (52%) are dissatisfied with the current Government (down five percentage points on September). Satisfaction levels with the Government remains higher amongst older (55+) voters.
- Micheál Martin's satisfaction rating slipped back by three percentage points to 48% (his October level) and he vies with Mary Lou McDonald for the most popular leader title. Currently, older (55+), middle class and farming community voters rate are more satisfied with his performance. Also 9 in 10 Fianna Fáil voters are satisfied with his performance.
- Mary Lou McDonald's satisfaction rating remains high with 48% (down 1%) of voters satisfied with her performance.
- Leo Varadkar's satisfaction level is stable at 42% for the third month in a row. Interestingly, his highest satisfaction ratings emerge amongst the same cohorts as Michael Martin; older, middle class and farming communities.
- Eamon Ryan's satisfaction rating remains at 30%.
- Ivana Bacik's rating has slipped back two percentage points to 42%, with her strongest satisfaction emerging amongst older, middle class and Dublin voters.

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

- No significant movements are evident across the party support figures.
- Sinn Féin commands a solid 34% support for the third wave in a row and they remain the most popular party.
- Fianna Fáil's support has decreased by two percentage points to 21% (not significant).
- As Leo Varadkar is poised to reclaim the top job, Fine Gael increased by two percentage points to 23%.
- Labour dropped two percentage points to 3%.
- The Green Party increased by one percentage point to 5%.
- The Social Democrats have a 1% support level.
- On RTÉ's recent Late Late Show, Sinn Féin leader Mary Lou McDonald did not rule out forming a government with Fine Gael after the next general election. She undoubtedly has her sights on becoming the country's first woman Taoiseach and based on the consistent performance at a party and personal level in the B&A/Sunday Times Polls, who would bet against her at this point in time.
