


Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown



Commentary

B&A

Background

- This Sunday Times / Behaviour & Attitudes (B&A) poll was conducted 2nd – 14th February 2023.
- Compared to the previous poll period, February has been somewhat muted, with the financial hangover post Christmas not as bad as expected, and economic forecasts improving somewhat. The labour market remains strong, with recent job losses in tech firms showing minimal negative impact.
- Nevertheless, although inflation appears to be slowing, the cost-of-living crisis still remains stark for the majority of Irish society. Hence the pending new cost-of-living spending package is being eagerly anticipated.
- The housing crisis continued to rear its head. With the eviction ban for tenants of rentals due to expire in the coming month, there have been growing calls from Sinn Féin to extend until the end of the year, while the latest Daft.ie rental report highlighted a 13.7% increase on rents in Ireland since the previous year. These increases in isolation may be manageable for some, however paired with the increases in household bills and general spend, the average person is continuing to struggle with the ‘optimistic economic outlook’ not reflecting the on-the-ground experience.
- Though more muted in recent weeks, protests on immigration continued, as right-wing groups attempt to exploit the struggles of the everyday person in Ireland, to stoke up unrest and division. These protests have resulted in some hesitancy among hoteliers to accept government contracts to host refugees, bringing about fears around accommodation for these individuals. Political parties will need to tread carefully on this issue, as it will undoubtedly impact some more than others.

Government and Leader Satisfaction Levels

- The current Government satisfaction remains at 41% (similar for the past three waves). Satisfaction levels with the Government remains higher amongst older (55+) voters (61%) and middle class voters (58%).
- Just over half of voters (52%) are dissatisfied with the current Government.
- Micheál Martin's satisfaction rating continues to improve, now standing at 52%, compared to 48% in December, and he retains the most popular leader title.
- Mary Lou McDonald's satisfaction rating has recovered, with 50% now satisfied with her performance (highest since June 2022).
- Leo Varadkar's satisfaction level is stable at 41%.
- Eamon Ryan's satisfaction rating also remains solid at 32%.
- Ivana Bacik's rating is at 45%, making her the third most popular leader.

Party Support Levels

- Sinn Féin's support drops by three percentage points to 31% support among voters – a level they have not been at in our polls since October 2021. However, they remain the most popular party. Navigating the challenges of housing and immigration will need careful handling going forward by all parties. Also, status quo challenger parties such as Sinn Féin need to be clever in the battles they pick, as the events of January have shown. As a party grows, like any brand or organisation, the leadership will require more support from a strong senior team (in this case shadow Ministers) to perform at a consistently high level.
- Fine Gael has recovered by four percentage points to 23%, indicating the impact of previous media scrutiny was short-lived. This is the best performance since March 2022 with the return of Leo Varadkar as Taoiseach showing dividends.
- Meanwhile, Fianna Fáil support has remained pretty steady at 24%.
- Independents' support levels have also remained stable at 9%.
- Labour has increased by one percentage point to 5%.
- The Green Party have 5% support.
- The Social Democrats remain at 2%, while Solidarity/PBP register at 1%.
- Overall, total Government support has increased by three percentage points as they navigate some very tricky waters. Sinn Féin still maintain their individual party dominance so far in 2023, however these are tough times with some challenges that are not easily fixed. It will be interesting to see over the coming months, how they will address such challenges.
